DESCRIPTION:

APOC 122 Aqua Bond Wet/Dry Flashing Cement is a professional grade cement that provides superior adhesion to vertical surfaces and superior bond to wet or underwater surfaces, with unique water displacement. properties. It will not run or sag and is formulated for year-round use in adverse weather conditions. APOC 122 is great for use as an emergency roof cement in harsh, wet conditions. APOC 122 is excellent for setting and repairing flashings, gutters, sills, lintels, copings, chimneys, skylights and seams. APOC 122 is also an excellent utility mastic for use below grade in heavy duty foundation waterproofing and dampproofing systems. For EPDM, TPO, PVC or other rubber/synthetic surfaces, use APOC Incredible® Fleece-Top® Tape and seal with an APOC approved sealant.

PREPARATION:

All surfaces must be completely clean, have proper drainage and be free of surface rust, dust and any other foreign matter. For longevity and UV protection, it is recommended to protect repairs with the application of a reflective coating after they have cured for 30-90 days. DO NOT HEAT OR THIN products. Not for use on single ply membranes. Apply to roofs in structurally sound condition.

APPLICATION:

For exterior use only. Apply when surface temperatures are between 20°F and 180°F (-6°C and 82°C). In colder weather, product should be stored at ambient temperatures 65°F to 80°F (18°C to 26°C) at least 24 hours prior to application. Product formulated to be used year-round. Protective clothing, gloves and eyewear should be used during application of these products. Apply with a trowel or putty knife. Work material to an even consistency over and into the area to be repaired. Using the "3-course" method, apply cement 1/8" thick, two or three inches beyond the problem area. Then reinforce the repair and embed a strip of APOC 483 polyester or APOC cotton reinforcing fabric. Brush fabric to ensure it is fully saturated from the bottom side up. Finally, cover the fabric with an additional layer



of cement. Form a feathered edge with cement where chimneys, vent pipes, and other projections meet the roof line.

COVERAGE RATE:

Approximately 12.5 sq. ft. /gal. @ 1/8" thick

CLEAN-UP:

Tools are best cleaned with xylene, but paint thinner, mineral spirits or a citrus degreaser may also be used.

PRECAUTIONS:

Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood. Obtain special instructions before use. Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking. Ground/bond container and receiving equipment. Use explosion-proof electrical/ventilating/ lighting/intrinsically safe equipment. Use only non-sparking tools. Take precautionary measures against static discharge. Do not breathe mist/vapors/spray. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection and face protection. Use in a well-ventilated area. Avoid release to the environment. Wash all exposed external body areas thoroughly after handling.
